

JBNA Directors' Report: March 2019

CRD Wastewater Project update:

- Pipe installation continues at each end of the pipe; 700 metres of pipe installed.
- Work ongoing between Niagara and Montreal and between Cambridge and Cook.
- Utility relocation continues between Government and Douglas in advance of pipe installation.
- CRD will be issuing a Dallas Road construction update in March 2019. Sections #2 and #6 are anticipated to be next.

Dallas sidewalk widening near Ogden:

JBNA has been contacted by City staff regarding the possibility of widening the west sidewalk by 2 ft. on Dallas Road between Anglers and Dock Street past the Pilotage building. The City hopes to use the CRD's obligation to reconstruct the area trenched for the wastewater pipe-lay along Dallas Road to cover much of the cost.
