CRD Wastewater Project – Dallas Rd – FULL ROAD CLOSURE:

Dallas will be closed from Monday through Friday during July and August between Government and Douglas. A detour along Government and Niagara will be in effect. Dallas will be open on the weekends.

Traffic control personnel will assist residents with access to their properties. Emergency service vehicles will be given access at all times and pedestrian access will be maintained on the north side of Dallas Rd.

Construction of the cycle path will also begin this summer.
