CRD Wastewater Project – Dallas Rd:

Pipe installation for the Clover Forcemain was completed in mid-August. Work has shifted to construction of the cycle path and restoration. This work also includes completing some utility relocation between Government and Douglas. There will be some road closures between Government and Douglas during work hours. Dallas Road will be open overnight.

A large flat circular concrete chamber south of Dallas near the Olympia Street intersection will serve as an access point for the forcemain. The 'vent' extension is not directly connected to the pipe. The purpose of vents is to exchange air from within the chambers – venting is intermittent and any air (from air release valves) is treated prior to discharging through the vent.
