- Original concept was a fully electric shuttle fleet
- 1st 100% Electric bus in North America was delivered in October of 2016
- 2nd 100% Electric bus was delivered in June of 2018
- 3-Million-dollar investment

SHUTTLE SERVICE

- PNWTS operates the shuttle service on behalf of the GVHA
- Our responsibility to transport guests safely and efficiently into the downtown core
- Shuttles are ready to run as soon as guests and crew disembark
- The last shuttle returns guests back to the terminal one hour prior to the ships ETD
- We run the shuttle every time a ship is in port
- Shuttle Pricing: \$5 USD – \$15 CAD

SHORE EXCURSIONS

- Shore Excursions are the tour passengers purchase onboard their ship
- They are pre-arranged through local Tour Operators who arrange with local venues
