

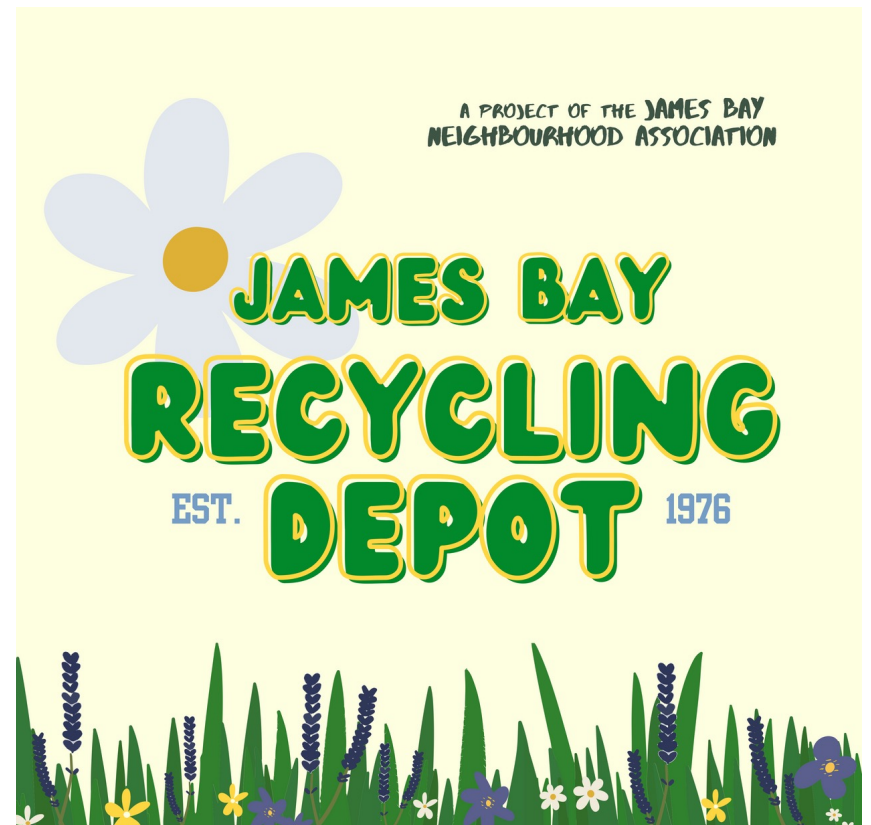
Community Coordinator Highlights

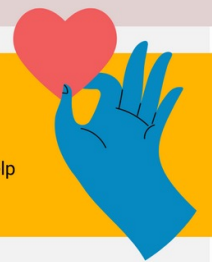
